WATER DAMAGE ACTION PLAN

5 IMMEDIATE STEPS YOU CAN TAKE

SAFETY FIRST

ELECTRICTY and water don't mix. Be careful before walking in standing water without shutting off power to appliances, outlets, and switches. Don't try to plug anything in, turn anything on, or try to vacuum up the water. CAREFUL not to track potential bacteria by moving contaminated contents from the affected area and through or into an unaffected area.

TURN OFF THE WATER

Turn off the source of the water if it is accessible. You may be able to turn the water off at the leak or if all else fails, turn the water off at the supply shut off valve (often located in a basement).

MINIMIZE DAMAGE

If some contents are in immediate danger of damage, you can attempt to move them to unaffected rooms. Give priority to hard to replace items or those that are important to running the business. Careful not to create more damage by tracking contamination into clean areas.

PROTECT FURNITURE AND CARPET

If you have wooden furniture on wet carpet or in low standing water, you can protect the carpet from staining and water from wicking into the wooden furniture with plastic bags, aluminum foil, or even placing the item on saucers.
